


PANAMA EARTHQUAKE RISK PROFILE



Panama is an independent country located in the sourthen part of Central America. The construction of the interoceanic canal has made it a commercial hub in the region. Panama City, the most populated urban center, is characterized by tall buldings mixing residential and commercial occupancies. Only a small portion of the population resides in zones of high seismic hazard.
